As used in this contract 'ticket' means this passenger ticket and baggage checks, or the innerary/receipt if applicable, in the case of an electronic ticket, of which these conditions and the notices form part, "carriage" is equivalent to 'transportation', 'carrier' means all air carries that carry or undertake to carry you or your baggage under this ticket or perform any other service incidental to such air carriage, "electronic ticket means the litnerary/Receipt issued by or on behalf of Carrier, the Electronic Coupons and, if applicable, a boarding document 'We' or 'us' means US-BANGLA AIRLINES. 
